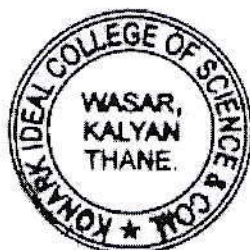

SC/ST CELL POLICY

The committee will suggest measures to prevent atrocities, if any against the members of SC/ST students in college and to ensure the feeling of security amongst them as per the provisions in the said Act.
